
THE DAYS OF NOAH

“For as in in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and did not know until the flood came and took them all away...” (Mat 24:38,39)

“...so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.” (Mat 24:39) THIS IS A PROMISE!

THE DAYS OF NOAH

- It was God's idea to build the ark (Gen 6:14)
- God set the standard (Gen 6:14)
- The ark was the exclusive means of salvation
- *“The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us...”*
- Baptism in comparison with Noah's salvation

- 
- “God remembered Noah and all the beasts and all the cattle that were with him in the ark...” (Gen 8:1)
 - God covenant with creation (Gen 8:20-22)
 - God’s covenant with Noah, his descendants and every living creature (9:1-17)
 - “...the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all flesh.”


