"Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah -- 32 not according to the covenant that | made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the ORD...."

#### Colossians 2:11-15

What was nailed to the cross?

#### **Hebrews 8:6-13**

- The new covenant is based on better promises
- The old covenant had a fault
- The old covenant was built on the idea of atonement sacrifices
- The old covenant had limited application

## Why was it removed?

#### **Hebrews 8:6-13**

- The old law was temporary
- Though it was removed, it does not mean it is now useless
- The old covenant gives evidence of God's purpose
- The old law provides examples

## Why was it removed?

#### **Hebrews 8:6-13**

- The old covenant was not intended to be binding forever (Gal 3:15-29)
- When Jesus died on the cross the old law was "nailed to the cross" (Col 2:11-14; Mat 5:17-18)
- Our relationship with God is based upon the gospel (1 Cor 15:1-4)

#### Conclusion

- Understanding the nature and purpose of the covenants is key to "rightly dividing the word of God" (2 Tim 2:15)
